

INTRODUCTION

This report presents a summary and analysis of the Prop B Parks Virtual Showcase held between July 25, 2023, to August 4, 2023. The aim was to collect public feedback on the Buda Bonds Prop B Parks projects and the preliminary enhancements planned for Garison Park.

PROJECTS OVERVIEW

At the heart of the City of Buda's priorities lies the provision of quality outdoor amenities and green spaces for its residents. Proposition B, the second proposition of the 2021 Buda Bonds Program, focuses on enhancing and expanding local parks and recreational spaces by funding various projects that bring these spaces to life. Prop B projects include the initial phases of Garison Park improvements, the expansion of Garlic Creek Trail, enhancements at Eastside Park, Onion Creek Trail, Green Meadows Park, Stoneridge Park, and the City Park Parking lot.

From July 25, 2023, to August 4, 2023, the City of Buda hosted the virtual showcase on the Buda Bonds website, seeking community feedback through a 15-question survey designed to capture participant insights on the projects. During the showcase, a total of 24 survey responses were collected. Below you will find a summary of the outreach initiatives, complete with data metrics and survey outcomes.

PROMOTION

The engagement activities involved promoting the virtual showcase through invitations and newsletters to stakeholders, along with the Green Meadows Pavilion Ribbon Cutting ceremony, and coverage across press and social media platforms:

Emails and Newsletters


On July 31, 2023, the Buda Viewda newsletter announced the Buda Bonds Parks Virtual Showcase, with a readership that extended to 376 stakeholders. The aim was to encourage Buda residents to provide feedback through the survey.


Between July 14, 2023, and July 25, 2023, 621 subscribers of the Buda Bonds e-newsletter received invitations and reminders. On July 19, 2023, 130 stakeholders received announcements through the Buda Project Dispatch.

Event

During the Green Meadows Pavilion Ribbon Cutting Ceremony on July 29, 2023, City officials encouraged attendees to respond to the survey. Approximately 25 people were in attendance.



SURVEY SUMMARY KEY TAKEAWAYS

From July 25, 2023, to August 4, 2023, the Buda community had the opportunity to share their feedback on preliminary plans to improve Garison Park. Overall, the preliminary plans to improve Garison Park received positive feedback from the Buda community.

Here is what we heard from the community:

Feedback Highlights for Proposed Garison Park Improvements:

Key Themes:

- Most survey respondents believed that the park's design concepts effectively reflect the community's needs. Other respondents recommended the possibility of eventual additional improvements to ensure the park's long-term usability.
- Survey respondents were enthusiastic about the park's potential to attract visitors who would enjoy its natural beauty.
- Many respondents emphasized the importance of finding a balance between making the park visually appealing and ensuring its sustainability.
- Most respondents agreed that the design is inclusive, offering spaces for educational activities that would cater to a diverse range of people.



- Respondents were particularly excited about features like the swimming hole and the overlook area.
- Participants emphasized the need for access to water, walking trails, and creating a safe environment that could be enjoyed by people of all ages.
- There were suggestions for various events, activities, amenities, and potential partnerships to enhance the park's overall appeal and functionality.

Prop B Parks Improvements Survey: Participants were asked to share comments and questions on any of the following Prop B Parks and Recreation projects:

City Park Parking Lot

Respondents shared opinions about the design and environmental impact of the parking lot, highlighting the importance of minimizing impervious cover and considering multifunctional usage.

Eastside Park Land Acquisition

Respondents noted the need for an appealing park on the Eastside of the City, amenities like indoor recreational centers, pickleball courts, and collaboration with neighboring communities.

Garlic Creek Trail Phase II:

Participants expressed mixed opinions on the trail project. Some favored preserving natural biking trails, suggesting enhancements like an additional crossing over Garlic Creek. Others were excited about the project but urged against paving, proposing educational markers and barriers to prevent motorized vehicle damage.

Green Meadows and Stoneridge Parks:

Respondents noted concerns about the current state of Green Meadows and Stoneridge Parks, noting issues like playground repairs, insufficient lighting, and the use of bond money. Some participants appreciate the construction of the new pavilion.

Overall, the community's feedback on the projects was notably favorable, highlighting a strong sense of enthusiasm, support, and anticipation for the upcoming park improvements and initiatives.
